

PUBLIC WORKS - ROADS DEPARTMENT

Road Allowance Culvert Installation Policy:

The landowner will provide proof of ownership from the Lands/Membership Department prior to the installation of a road allowance culvert.

Any entrance culverts on the road allowance shall be installed by the Public Works Department at the Roads Department's specifications and determined rate or residents may hire a contractor of choice provided they meet specifications as set by the Public Works Department for a standard fee of \$125.00.

Any owner of a road allowance culvert that makes a request to move their culvert will be responsible for all monetary costs, including any new material.

Based upon the size of the culvert required and cost for installation, the purchaser of the culvert for residential and commercial purposes, will pay 100% of the costs.

Costs are payable at the Public Works Office by cash, certified cheque or money order prior to the installation of the culvert. In addition, an appropriate form setting out the lot, concession number and township, must be completed and signed by the property owner.

Oversized culverts will be priced as required.

The Public Works Department will replace damaged culverts and maintain washed out or plugged culverts only.

Any unauthorized culverts on Six Nations Territory will be removed by Six Nations Public Works Roads Department at the expense of the property owner.
