

**PRE-APPROVAL PROCEDURE FOR PROCESSING
ROOFING, SHINGLES & CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS MATERIALS
AT THE SIX NATIONS LANDFILL SITE**

Any Band Member in Breach of this policy on the “Authorization for Disposal of Construction Debris at the Six Nations Landfill” will lose the privilege to use the Six Nations Landfill Site. The Authorization Form, which includes the Pre-approval Procedure, are subject to a site inspection. A form must be completed by the property owner and the person hauling on their behalf.

The following procedure has been established for disposal of roofing, shingles, cement, burnt house debris and construction debris at the Six Nations Landfill site. These types of materials can not be disposed of in the Landfill Site trenches without pre-approval.

An "Authorization for Disposal of Construction Debris at the Six Nations Landfill Site" form can be obtained at the Public Works Office for completion by Six Nations Residents ONLY. This form is required only when the resident is requesting disposal of roofing, shingles, cement, burnt house debris and construction debris. Please be advised that all approvals must be signed prior to 10:00 a.m. every Friday morning for any weekend disposal on Saturday. Metal, wood, cement, shingles and drywall to be separated and disposed of in designated areas.

Burnt House Material, Construction Debris, Cement, Shingles/Roofing Debris:

The resident fully completes the Authorization form at the Public Works Office (445-4242).

The appropriate authority will visit the location where the material is originating from and confirm with the homeowner what type of debris and amount or volume is being disposed of. If the homeowner cannot confirm the roofing or shingles are from their residence OR if the appropriate authority is not satisfied that the material was generated from the residence, approval will not be authorized for disposal at the Six Nations Landfill Site. Once approved, the homeowner shall have 72 hours to dispose of the approved debris.

The Landfill Site Guard will be advised to allow the contractor to proceed with the disposal. The Landfill Site Guard will collect the signed papers and return to the Public Works Admin Office for filing.

The vehicle bringing the debris to the Landfill Site for disposal must stop at the Landfill Site Guard House and provide the Landfill Guard with the completed and signed Authorization for Disposal before proceeding to the trench for disposal. Homeowners/contractors will ensure that all material is separated into the designated area as outlined by signs posted at the Landfill Site.
