Toll Booth Rules & Regulations Policy:

Public Works will receive written requests from Six Nations Youth (18 and under) Organizations to hold toll booths in the Village of Ohsweken. Individual teams will not be approved for a toll booth, however the overall organization may request the toll booth. ie; Minor Ball Association, Minor Lacrosse Association, Six Nations Elementary Schools, etc.

- ✓ toll booths will be available from the month of May to the first weekend in November, two times per month, on a Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon (excluding holiday weekends of May 24th weekend & Ohsweken Fall Fair weekend);
- ✓ only one toll booth per organization will be permitted each season;
- ✓ toll booths will be restricted to the Village of Ohsweken;
- ✓ representatives can stand only on the right side of the roads that lead into Ohsweken;
- ✓ an adult must supervise each toll booth at all times throughout the time specified above;
- ✓ no person under the age of 16 years will be permitted to participate in toll booth collections;
- ✓ participants must wear safety/identification vests;
- ✓ receipts for donations will be provided to prevent continual collections;
- ✓ proper signs to be posted on the road to give the public advanced warning of the toll booths ahead;
- ✓ traffic backup will not occur as a result of the toll booths;
- ✓ Public Works nor Six Nations Council will not be responsible for any personal injuries or property damage as a result of this toll booth.
- ✓ Six Nations Police will be advised of all Tolls Booths events scheduled.
- ✓ If an organization does not adhere to these rules and regulations, the toll booth may be terminated and future requests to hold a toll booth will be denied.
- ✓ No drugs or alcohol will be tolerated.
