

PUBLIC WORKS - WATER/SEWER DEPARTMENT

Water Truck Loading Station Policy:

The current water rate established by the Six Nations Council for the loading station is as follows:

\$1.00 per cubic meter

Numbered cards will be assigned and recorded at the Public Works Office during business hours. For customers who do not have a card, they must use the public tap

There is an Advance Deposit of \$50.00 required for those wishing to purchase a card. Each customer then becomes responsible for his/her card and if it is lost, the advance deposit is forfeited and a further \$50.00 deposit is required for a new card.

When a customer's account is in arrears of two billing periods, a letter will be sent informing the customer that they have thirty days to bring their account into balance, or face possible de-activation of truckfill card. After the third billing period and no payment received, customer's truckfill card is de-activated and a letter sent requesting full payment before the card is re-activated.

All persons using the Water Truck Loading Station to fill water tanks containing chemicals must use their own detachable hose.

FOR RESIDENTS WHO WISH TO OBTAIN WATER IN SMALL AMOUNTS (JUGS OR PAILS), A PUBLIC WATER TAP HAS BEEN INSTALLED AT THE WATER TRUCK LOADING STATION, FREE OF CHARGE.

The Public Works Department reserves the right to restrict the use of the Truck Loading Station, as required.
