



Indoor/Outdoor Visitation - Update

Date: October 13, 2020

Due to the increased number of cases in the community, Iroquois Lodge has stopped all indoor and outdoor general visits.

Essential Visitors will still be permitted as long as they have a negative COVID-19 test in the past two weeks and pass the screening upon entry to the building.

We understand that this will be challenging for families and residents. This is a preventative step to continue to keep the home COVID-free.

Essential Visitors include:

a person performing an essential support service within the Long-Term Care home (i.e. government inspector, contractor, lab technician) or a person visiting a palliative or critically ill resident. This also includes a Designated Caregiver, someone designated by the resident to provide direct care to the resident.

In addition, we will increase COVID-19 testing in staff. We have been testing every two weeks since the spring. We will start testing every week effective today.

We commit to using virtual methods to support ongoing connections between families and residents. If you wish to book a virtual visit with one of the residents please contact Iroquois Lodge at 519-445-2224.
