



The Six Nations Elected Council has committed the following Ontario First Nations Limited Partnership (\$10.5 million) and the Ontario Casino Agreement – Brantford Casino funds (\$4.5 million) to the following recipients for the 2019/2020 fiscal year.

We were unfortunately unable to provide full support to all requests for the first year of Brantford Casino funds, as they totalled well over \$8 million. The community need continues to outpace the income. We will continue to examine opportunities for financial resources to ensure that we are meeting the current needs of the community, and also charting a path to ensure the wellbeing and prosperity of our future generations.
