Intensive Services Program

The Intensive Service worker is a short term service provided by

Six Nations

Child & Family Services

The Intensive Service Worker will work intensively with the children ages 0-6 and their families.

Appropriate referrals will be made as needed.



Intensive Services Goals

The Intensive Services will increase services made available to children 0-6 and their families.

The Intensive Service will provide educational/awareness of Early Childhood Development and mental health challenges which families may be faced with in their day to day interactions with their children.

The Intensive Service Worker will implement recommendations made by i.e. Child Psychiatrist, Pediatricians or Lansdowne Children's Centre, working in collaboration with the community agency and parent for the child.
