



COMMUNITY NOTICE: **59TH ELECTED COUNCIL UPDATES – MAY 12, 2025**

OHSEWEN, ON – Six Nations of the Grand River 59th Elected Council (SNGREC) shares the following updates with community from their May 12, 2025 meeting.

Stance on Tariffs

- SNGREC has a vested interest in ensuring that external government policies respect First Nations inherent, Treaty, and constitutional rights.
- SNGREC opposes any tariffs, trade policies, or economic measures that threatens our economy. SNGREC calls on all external governments to include SNGR in tariff discussions that pertain to, and uphold, our inherent, Treaty, and constitutional rights.

Glebe Farm Property Environmental Site Assessment

- To ensure the safety of our community, SNGREC has commissioned Phase I and Phase II Environmental Site Assessments for the Glebe Farm Property. These assessments are funded by Indigenous Services Canada.

Canada Housing and Infrastructure Fund

- SNGREC approved the Department of Public Works application to the Canada Housing and Infrastructure Fund to expand the wastewater treatment plant on Six Nations. If funded, an expanded wastewater treatment plans supports the ability to service more homes in the community.

Indigenous Children Eye Examination (ICEE) Program

- SNGREC has agreed to explore bringing a comprehensive eye examination program for children to the community. More updates will be shared with community once details are known.
