OHSWEKEN, ON – Six Nations of the Grand River 59th Elected Council (SNGREC) shares the following updates with community from their August 18, 2025, meeting.

Road Resurfacing Project

- SNGREC has approved and awarded a bid to Dufferin Construction Company to begin the 2025 road resurfacing project.
- The source of funds for this project is identified as the Fuel Charge Proceeds Fund for Indigenous Governments.
- Please be advised that delays and lane restrictions will be in effect on the following roads from August 25 through the anticipated completion date of October 2:
- o Fourth Line between Seneca and Mohawk Road
- o Fourth Line between Cayuga Road and railroad tracks
- O Chiefswood Road between Second and Third Line

On-Reserve Housing Program - Housing Gaps Fund

- Six Nations Housing has applied for the On-Reserve Housing Program Housing Gaps Fund to construct a 5-unit townhome.
- Partial funding was secured from Indigenous Services Canada (ISC) in the amount of \$1,419,000.
- Following approval of this application, ISC identified a shortfall in providing the full funding amount.
- However, Six Nations of the Grand River (SNGR) have available funds within the First Nation
 Children's Housing Fund (FNCHF) that can be reallocated to cover the remaining cost to continue
 the project.

Six Nations Maternal & Child Centre Renovations

 SNGREC has accepted the proposal from Two Row Architect to complete the assessment, design, tendering, and contract administration for the completion of renovations at the Six Nations Maternal & Child Centre.

Additions to Reserve (ATR) Dyjach and Sloat Properties

- SNGREC has approved for QM Environmental to complete the demolition of two ATR properties, Dyjach and Sloat.
- Demolition costs were covered by monies from the Economic Development Fund.
