OHSWEKEN, ON – Six Nations of the Grand River 59th Elected Council (SNGREC) shares the following updates with community from their November 24, 2025, meeting.

Six Nations Gaming Commission

- SNGREC will own and operate all commercial gaming within the Six Nations of the Grand River Territory, both land-based and online.
- Certain types of gaming may still be conducted by Six Nations individuals or organizations, but only if they are licensed by the Six Nations Gaming Commission. These exceptions include:
- o Raffle draws, 50/50, scratch boards, sports pools
- Monte Carlo Community Event
- Nevada tickets
- Chase the Ace

• SNGREC has extended the Moratorium on the issuance and renewal of cannabis licenses by the Six Nations Cannabis Commission for another three (3) months, with a new expiry date of February 25, 2026.
