OHSWEKEN, ON – Six Nations of the Grand River 59th Elected Council (SNGREC) shares the following updates with community from their February 2, 2026, meeting.

Six Nations Tourism – Welcome Centre

- Six Nations Tourism has secured major funding for the Welcome Centre build; including:
 - \$1.2 million from the National Aboriginal Capital Corporations Association through the Signature Indigenous Tourism Experiences Stream,
 - \$225,000 from the FedDev Tourism Growth Fund, and
 - \$300,000 in revenue generated by the department.
- Six Nations Tourism has now fully secured the funds required to complete the project.
- Six Nations Tourism also recently received the Indigenous Tourism Award at the Ontario Tourism Summit on October 29, 2025, in Ottawa. They were also named one of three national finalists for the Indigenous Tourism Award at the Canadian Tourism Awards.
