OHSWEKEN, ON – Six Nations of the Grand River 59th Elected Council (SNGREC) shares the following updates with community from their March 2, 2026, meeting.

Phase 2: Greener Neighbourhood Pilot Program Update

- On May 5, 2025, Six Nations of the Grand River (SNGR) and Natural Resources Canada entered into a Contribution Agreement for the Greener Neighbourhood Pilot Program in the amount of \$1,159,390. The intention of this program was to reduce the energy consumption and greenhouse gas emissions within SNGR housing rental units.
- Due to unforeseen financial requirements, SNGR Housing will not be pursuing Phase 2 of this program.

Lease Agreements

- SNGREC continues to identify an urgent need for space based on the health and safety of SNGR staff and community members.
- SNGREC, along with Senior Administration, are currently revisiting current leases to explore potential office space availability for SNGR programs and services.
