New Long-Term Care Home – Location

- HDR Architecture and Associates Inc. is progressing toward a first draft or conceptual design phase of the new Long-Term Care Home.
- The information, evidence, and expert opinion gathered does not identify any significant risks to the site location that would require reconsideration of a new site or further assessments required.
- SNGREC reaffirms its support for the approved Sunrise Court location and authorizes continued advancement of the conceptual design phase at the site.
